This form is due the last week of each marking period and the final grade, determined by your conductor will count as 30% of your average. (Playing tests, concerts, auditions = 60%; written =10%)

Responsibility 1: You brought to class every day all materials and supplies needed for your learning. This includes instrument, music, and pencil. You are punctual to class and in your seat ready to tune within two minutes of the bell. You returned all documents sent home to be signed within 5 school days. **Responsibility 2:** You did not chew gum, eat during class, or have nails that were inappropriate length for playing a string instrument. (Each Responsibility is worth ½ the points)

Dependability: Learned to perform the music properly, participated in concerts, rehearsals, and other group activities and attended class with minimal excused absences. (An unexcused absence from a performance equals a zero for this category.)

Individual Practice: Calculate your average weekly practice in minutes. (Philharmonic participation suggests 100 or more minutes per week.) No practice = zero.
Over 180 minutes/week = 25; 150 = 20; 120 = 18; 100 = 15; 60 = 10; 30 = 5; less than 30 = 1 _____

Improvement in Skills: You improved your abilities in understanding music notation, how to play your instrument (including your bowing), and how to contribute musically to an ensemble.
Outstanding = 15; Excellent = 12; Good = 9, Average = 6; Fair = 3, Little or none = 0 _____

Courtesy: You are polite to your classmates and conductor. You listened as others spoke, stayed quiet as others tuned and rehearsed their part. You showed appropriate conduct throughout the class.
