I. Introduction to Spanish

Vocabulary: Greetings, Farewells, , Numbers 0 – 59, Telling Time, Days of the Week, Months, Seasons, the Alphabet, Punctuations and accent marks

Grammar: Subject Pronouns, the verb to be

II. Getting to Know Each Other

Vocabulary: Describing friends, ,

Grammar: Using to be with adjectives, gender and adjective agreement, Forming questions, using nouns with definite articles, and discussing likes and dislikes

III. What Do You Like to Do?

Vocabulary: Sports and Leisure Activities, and weather expressions

Grammar: using –AR verbs and some irregular verbs

IV. School life

Vocabulary: School Supplies and items needed for school, classes, school events, and places at school

Grammar: indefinite articles, -er and –ir verbs, and other irregular verbs

V. Family

Vocabulary: Family members, rooms in the house, furniture and accessories, chores, places where people live

Grammar: Stem- changing verbs: o:ue and e:ie, estar, tocar and parecer, and negative terms

VI. Food

Vocabulary: Food for breakfast, lunch, and dinner, food from restaurant, describing food, table settings

Grammar: Using ser and estar, stem- changing verbs o:ue, e:i, direct object pronouns, informal commands

VII. The Body

Vocabulary: Parts of the body, daily routine

Grammar: Reflexive verbs
