### **Expressions followed by infinitives**

Deber = should, to ought to

Tener que = to have to

me/te/le/nos/les toca = to be someone's turn

are followed by an infinitive to say what one has to do.

Debes lavar los platos.

Marcos tiene que limpiar la sala.

Me toca sacar la basura.

Hay que = one must

Hacer el favor de = to do the favor of

favor de = favor of (please)

are followed by an infinitive to say what has to be done

Hay que sacudir los muebles antes de la fiesta.

Haz el favor de sacar la basura.

Favor de darle de comer al gato.

### **Ser v. Estar**

Ser = to be

where an event takes place

descriptions

where one is from

time/date

Estar = to be

current location

feelings

what one is doing right now (gerund/present participle)

Remember – “How you feel and where you are – always use the verb estar – G!” (g = gerund = -ing)
