# Telling someone what to do...

- If you are telling someone to DO something... here's what to do –
  - Drop the –s of the “tú” form of the verb
- Por ejemplo:
  - Take out the trash!
    - ¡Saca la basura!
  - Clean the bathroom
    - ¡Limpia el baño!

# Remember...

- You can attach a Direct Object Pronoun to a positive command.
  - Take out the trash.
    - ¡Saca la basura!
  - Take it out!
    - ¡Sácala!
      - Notice the accent mark...
      - Count back 2 syllables/vowels

# Irregular Positive...

- Hacer – Haz
- Poner – Pon
- Ir – Ve
- Salir – Sal
- Ser – Sé
- Tener – Ten
- Venir - Ven

# Don't do that!

- To tell someone NOT to do something...
  - Find the “yo” form of the verb.
  - Drop the –o
  - For –ar verbs, add –es
  - For –er or –ir verbs, add –as
- FYI – you cannot attach a pronoun to a negative command – just put it before the verb.

# Por ejemplo...

- Don't talk!
  - ¡No hables!
- Don't eat the taco!
  - ¡No comas el taco!
- Don't set the table!
  - ¡No pongas la mesa!

# Irregular Negative

- Ir – no vayas
- Dar – no des
- Ser – no seas
- Verbs that end in:
  - gar – gues (no llegues tarde)
  - car – ques (no toques)
  - zar – ces (no empieces temprano)
