PRESENTATIONS

You must complete both of the following.. If you want to work with someone, obviously the content must be more. You may give me a proposal to be approved in that case. Each will count 3 times. You will have some opportunity to work on the region project in class, but you will need to work on it mostly outside of class in order to do a good job.

Power Point I: Create a power point of at least 10 slides with French sentences describing each. I must approve the content before your presentation.

- Moi
- Mes amis/ma famille
- Ma maison/ma chambre
- Mon lycée
- Mon weekend
- You may create your own idea (must be approved)

Power Point II: You will research a region of France to present to the class. Counts three times. Due dates will be announced at least 3 weeks in advanced.

COMPOSITIONS

You will be assigned 8-10 compositions. Most will be at least 15 sentences. Other requirements will vary according to the assignment. You will always have a chance to turn in a draft for corrections in advance. If you don't take advantage of this chance, you are on your own! Each will count once.

DICTEES

You will get a dictation on Monday and will have the test on the dictation on Tuesday of each week. We will adjust to holidays, missing class periods. These will usually count 1/2.

SKITS

Will be done about each 2 weeks. They will usually count 1/2.

HOMEWORK: Will be limited to being prepared for Daily Grammar Review, which we will go over at the beginning of class each day. Also, you are to study daily and keep your notebook organized.

EXTRA CREDIT OPPORTUNITIES

There will be opportunities to choose up to 2 more poems for recitation. This will add 10 points to any test grade. (a test usually counts twice.)

You will have quizzes that count once on vocabulary or individual grammar points. You will also have some tests that will count either twice or three times.

The final exam will count for 10% of your grade.
