LATE AWARDS PALMETTO FELLOWS SCHOLARSHIP

In order to be eligible to apply for the Late Awards of the Palmetto Fellows Scholarship high school seniors must meet one of the following criteria:

Score a minimum **1200 SAT** or **27 ACT** by the June test administration (in order to determine the highest combined score, the score on the SAT must be calculated by using the highest Math score combined with the highest Critical Reading score); earn a cumulative 3.5 GPA on the Uniform Grading Scale at the end of the senior year; and rank in the top six percent at the end of the sophomore, junior or senior year.

OR

Score a minimum **1400 SAT** or **32 ACT** by the June test administration (in order to determine the highest combined score, the score on the SAT must be calculated by using the highest Math score combined with the highest Critical Reading score) **and** earn a cumulative 4.0 GPA on the Uniform Grading Scale at the end of the senior year.
