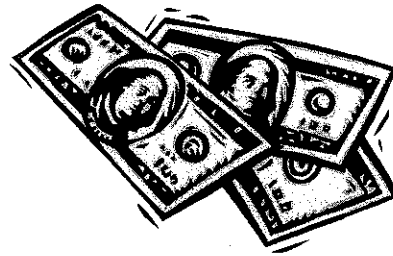

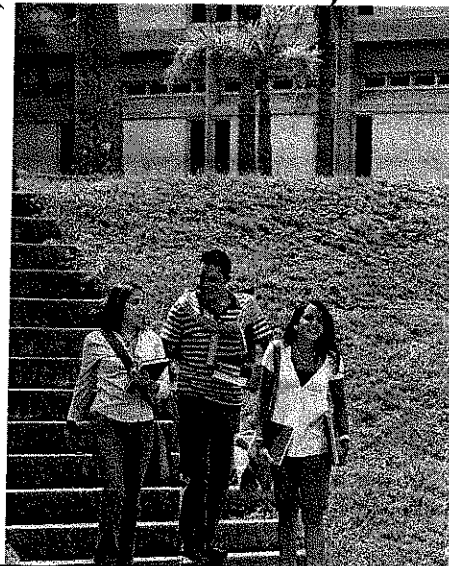

- Spring Break 2017... visit colleges (plan trip with parents and map out the schools).
Make sure you make an appointment with the College Admissions Offices.
- Summer 2017 start applying for scholarships.
